Update: On June 4, 2009 the City of Des Moines Responsible SEPA Official determined that the proposal by the South County Correctional Entity (SCORE) for construction of a misdemeanor jail facility to serve the needs of the Cities of Auburn, Burien, Des Moines, Federal Way, Renton, SeaTac, and Tukwila is not anticipated to create significant adverse environmental impacts and will not require preparation of an environmental impact statement.
